

Clayton Straw, the 18 year old son of Geo. Straw, who accidentally shot himself with a single-barreled shot gun while climbing over mention of which was made week, was alone at the time of the accident, but with great presence of mind and with abundance of pluck, removed his shirt and stuffed it into the gaping wound, four inches long and two inches wide in his left side, Gathering all his strength he hurried to his home a half mile away, reaching there in a much weakened condition. Dr. Wade, of Fremont, and Dr. McTaggart, of Ray, soon arrived and dressed the wound. They removed a few splinters of the rib, and believe he has a good chance to live. He is much improved at this writing.
